Setup overview

This booklet provides the information you need to unpack your server, cable and start your server, and install a network operating system (NOS). This booklet contains general information, such as features, help information, and a system illustration.

If you want detailed information or if you have options to install, refer to your *IBM Netfinity 3000 User's Handbook*.

These are the steps you will perform to set up your server and to ensure that your server is functioning properly.

- 1. Review the Safety Information book.
- 2. Unpack your server and verify the package inventory.
- 3. Cable your server.
- 4. Start your server and run the power-on self-test (POST).
- 5. Install your options.
- 6. Configure your hardware.
- 7. Install your software.


Cabling your server

- 1. Select a location that will allow for air circulation. Be sure to maintain minimum clearances around the server:
 - 102 mm (4 in.) in the front
 - 127 mm (5 in.) in the rear
 - 51 mm (2 in.) on the left and right sides
- 2. See the illustration below to help you connect the monitor, keyboard, and mouse cables to the server.
- 3. Connect all power cords to electrical outlets.
- 4. Continue with "Starting your server" on page 3.

Starting your server

- 1. Turn on your monitor; then, turn on your server. See the following illustration.
- 2. Observe your monitor.

When the system successfully completes its power-on self-test (POST), the prompt requesting that you insert startable (bootable) media appears.

Note: The following message will appear because the operating system has not been installed:



If any other error message appears, if you hear any beeps, or if your monitor screen is blank, refer to the "Solving Problems" chapter in your *IBM Netfinity 3000 User's Handbook* for instructions; then, continue with step 3.

- 3. In the table provided under "Server records and specifications" in your *IBM Netfinity 3000 User's Handbook*, record the server serial number and server key number.
- 4. Continue with "Installing your options" on page 4.

Installing your options

If you have options, install them now. Refer to the information provided with the option and your *IBM Netfinity 3000 User's Handbook* for installation instructions.

After you have installed all your options, return here and continue with "Installing your software" on page 5. Use the *IBM ServerGuide* CD-ROM package to configure your hardware and install your software.

Notes:

- When you install options, be sure that each option has a unique interrupt request (IRQ) assignment. Do not duplicate IRQs.
- When you install devices in bays 2, 3, 5, and 6, disable the termination for the devices before you install them.
- If you plan to install multiple network adapters, install only one at this time. After you have installed the operating system and it starts without errors, add the additional network adapters one at a time.
- If you have a modem or fax machine attached to the server and you are in the United Kingdom, plug in the power cords first; then, connect the telephone line to the wall outlet and the server.
- To connect the server 10BASE-T or 100BASE-TX port to a repeater, use an unshielded twisted pair (UTP) cable with RJ-45 connectors at both ends. An EIA/TIA-568 category 5 cable must be used for 10BASE-T and 100BASE-TX connectors to meet various standards, including electromagnetic compatibility.

If you do not have options to install, continue with "Installing your software" on page 5.

Installing your software

Your server includes a copy of IBM ServerGuide. The ServerGuide CDs provide a simplified server installation with device drivers tested for your server.

You can use the programs on the ServerGuide CDs to:

- Configure supported hardware directly from a CD.
- Automate some of the network operating system (NOS) installation steps.
- Detect the supported hardware installed in your server; then, provide device drivers tested for that hardware.

Note: Some of these system-specific device drivers are newer than those drivers included with off-the-shelf NOS packages.

- Provide a Replicated Installation path for installing Windows NT Server 4.0 on multiple servers.
- Install popular application programs directly from a CD.
- Install IBM Update Connector. Once this program is installed, you can connect your server to an IBM update Web site and receive any available device drivers, BIOS, and program updates (requires Windows NT Server 4.0 and TCP/IP access to the Internet).
- Install other application and utility programs.

For more information, refer to the documentation provided inside your ServerGuide package.

If you decide not to use ServerGuide to assist you with the installation of your NOS, you must download system-specific NOS installation instructions.


